



CONTACT LENS EVALUATION FEES CONTRACT

The contact lens evaluation fitting is an elective process and a separate procedure from the standard comprehensive exam. Therefore, there is an **additional charge**.

Why do I have to pay a Contact Lens Evaluation fee every year?

This is to ensure that your eyes are healthy and that the type of contact lenses worn previously is still the best for you. This also gives you a chance to try some newer brands with better technology that might improve your contact lens experience.

Does my insurance cover the Contact Lens Evaluation?

Some insurance plans do provide coverage for contact lenses and/or contact lens evaluation fees. It is best that you give us a call as different plans offer different coverages.

Contact Lens Evaluation/Fitting Includes (2 month follow-up care to be finalized):

- ❖ Determination of contact lens prescription
- ❖ Measurement of the cornea curvature
- ❖ Evaluation and assessment of contact lens fit and comfort, and how it affects the cornea, conjunctiva, tear film and eyelids
- ❖ Information about contact lens care, safety, and solutions
- ❖ All necessary trial contact lenses (some exclusions apply for specialty fits)
- ❖ Contact lens prescription valid for one year
- ❖ Care related to contact lens wear when contact lenses are purchased from Private Eyes Optometry

PLEASE NOTE: Failure to be finalized within 2 months of your initial fitting will result in a \$50 copay per visit thereafter. Beyond 4 months, an intermediate fitting fee will be charged ranging from \$80-\$120.
